6. CRIME UPDATE

6.1 Cottesloe Police

Snr Sgt Warburton and Snr Constable advised the Committee of the following:

- There has been a 12.9 percent increase in verified offences for the financial year with most offences occurring early morning.
 - Seven more burglaries (28 in total)
 - Eight more houses (24 in total)
 - Nine more stealing offences (76 in total)
 - Three more theft from car offences (38 in total) which is a major concern.
- New mapping program is being implemented to better target police resources.
- Improved communication between police and the Public Transport Authority.

6.2 WALGA Crime Statistics

The Committee noted the September 2018 crime statistics.

7. SENIOR RANGER REPORT

Ms Squiers advised the Committee of the following:

- Summer roster has commenced.
- There has been an increase in illegal camping.
- Rangers are assisting the police with CCTV footage of several incidents being provided.
- Body cameras are being trialled.

8. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT REPORT

Ms Hartley advised the Committee of the following:

- Cottesloe Primary School is developing signage for the 'kiss and go' area.
- North Cottesloe Primary School are still developing ideas for the road safety funding grant.
- Halloween event will be held at the Grove on 31 October 2018.

9.1 CCTV

Ms Squiers advised the Committee that the Station Street CCTV will be linked to the Civic Centre office.

9.2 Major Works Update

Mr Kan advised the Committee of the following:

- Beach Access Path works have commenced.
- Universal Access Ramp likely to be deferred due to high tender costs received.
- Shady seating will be installed mid December 2018.
- Quotes are being sought for the Foreshore Master Plan with consultants to be appointed at the end of November 2018.
- The Principal Shared Path from Grant Street to Victoria Street will be completed by the State as one project from late November 2018 to late February 2018.
