PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO LOCAL LAW

The Town is seeking comment on a proposed amendment to the Local Government Local Law in relation to additional activities which may be prohibited on specified local government property:

- releasing an unsecured balloon inflated with gas causing it to rise in the air
- smoking in contravention of a sign which prohibits the act of smoking
