Component 1: Float Up (4-5pm)

The float up is about getting everyone in the ocean to kick off summer. We will invite our guests to come to the beach with something that floats – a floating mattress, swim rings, etc. We have time to play in the water together.

We supply some inflatable pool toys (rings, octopuses) for those who've come down to the beach empty handed or are walking by and decide to join in.



Component 2: Yoga Class (5:30 -6:40pm)

Yoga mats are set up on the grass overlooking the Indian ocean. We have an incredible yoga teacher lead a beautiful class about gratitude and community.

After a 60min flow, we sit together on our mats to watch the sunset into the ocean.

Yogis roll up their mats and are invited on to the sand for the beach lounge and silent disco.

Component 3: Silent Disco & Beach Lounge (7-9pm)



We have 2 areas set up for our guests, both on the sand next to each other.

Silent Disco: We have 3 dj's spinning tracks for the silent disco where each person can choose their channel on their headphones.

Beach Lounge: We have lounges, bean bags and low tables set up for guests to sit and relax with their friends. We have acoustic live music in this area. We also have water and juice available to keep everyone hydrated.




Creating a Local Experience
