



Designated Areas for Dogs (Dog Act 1976)

The following areas are designated as Dog Exercise Areas:

- (a) The following public beaches:
 - (i) Southern Dog Beach - south of Dutch Inn Groyne to Cottesloe LGA southern boundary
 - (ii) Northern Dog Beach - from Lot 67 Marine Parade, to Cottesloe LGA northern boundary.

- (b) The following reserves:
 - (i) Grant Marine Park;
 - (ii) Andrews Place;
 - (iii) Jasper Green Reserve;
 - (iv) Cottesloe Oval;
 - (v) Harvey Field
 - (vi) John Black Dune Reserve
 - (vii) Sea View Golf Course between the hours of 6pm and 6am only and;
 - (viii) In Curtin Avenue:
 - (a) The area between Curtin Avenue pavement to Perth Transport Authority's (PTA) boundary fence line; from Eric Street to Forrest Street;
 - (b) The area between Curtin Avenue pavement to Perth Transport Authority's (PTA) boundary fence line; from Grant Street to Eric Street.
 - (ix) In Railway Street:
 - (a) The area between Railway Street pavement to Perth Transport Authority's (PTA) boundary fence line; from Congdon Street to Eric Street.
 - (b) The area between Railway Street pavement to Perth Transport Authority's (PTA) boundary fence line; from Eric Street to Burt Street.



The above dog exercise areas do not apply to –

- (a) land which has been set apart as a children's playground;
- (b) an area being used for sporting or other activities, as permitted by the local government, during the times of such use; or
- (c) a car park.

The following areas are where dogs are prohibited absolutely (excluding assistance dogs);

- (a) where so indicated by a sign;
- (b) a public building;
- (c) a food preparation area as per the requirements of the Food Act 2008;
- (e) a public beach not being a beach listed as designated dog exercise area
- (f) a children's playground.

NOTE: - As per the *Dog Act 1976* dogs shall be on a lead at all other times in public open spaces and under effective control.
