

## Foreshore Detailed Design – Toilet Facility

<p><b>1. Who designed the proposed facility?</b></p>	<p>ASPECT Studios</p>
<p><b>2. What is the location being considered for the toilet facility?</b></p>	<p>In the concept design the proposed location is opposite Napier Street (placing it adjacent to the future play equipment).</p>
<p><b>3. What does the facility include?</b></p>	<p>The design provides five unisex toilets, which includes one universal access toilet.</p>
<p><b>4. What are the dimensions of the facility?</b></p>	<p>The proposed dimensions are:          6.635m wide x 4.020m deep          6.835m height          The internal floor area is 17.6m<sup>2</sup>          Overall footprint area including veranda is 72.171m<sup>2</sup></p>
<p><b>5. What materials is the facility made from?</b></p>	<p>It is proposed natural materials will be used including natural limestone.</p>
<p><b>6. Why is the Town looking at installing more toilet facilities when there are existing facilities at Indiana's?</b></p>	<p>The Town is working towards future proofing the foreshore. An upgraded toilet facility here will address the needs of the many visitors to the foreshore.          The new toilet facility will complement the existing Indiana toilets and change rooms.</p>
<p><b>7. Has consideration been given to the impact of such an installation on the beach environment?</b></p>	<p>The project is complementary to its coastal geology, an ancient limestone setting, putting to use a material which is historically used in many of Perth's memorable buildings. Locally this material is seen along the foreshore in elements such as the Arch monument, Sundial, French memorial, beach terraces and limestone walling.</p>
	<p>The height of the structure allows for the penetration of natural daylight and the facility to be well ventilated. The</p>

	structure location is adjacent to two very tall Norfolk Island Pines trees, approximately 18m tall.

Has consideration been given to providing a toilet facility at another location within the foreshore precinct that is away from the immediate beach front?	<p>The purpose of placing a toilet facility here is to ensure access to the Foreshore's other amenities remain in close proximity for visitors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grassed terraces</li> <li>• Playgrounds</li> <li>• Beach access</li> <li>• Cafes/restaurants</li> </ul>
