

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Where is the Harvey Field Recreation Precinct?
This is located along Broome Street between Jarrad Street and Pearse Street.
2. Why are additional connecting footpaths outside the precinct provided?
This is to improve pedestrian connectivity and encourage sustainable travel options to Harvey Field.
3. What will the future football oval spectator seating look like and why is this provided?
This will be similar to the seating next to the Cottesloe Surf Lifesaving Club and is provided to cater for spectators wanting to sit at field level to watch the games
4. What works are involved with the carpark improvements and why is this being proposed?
Reinforced grass paving will be installed for the informal carpark surface along Broome Street and Pearse Street, as shown on the attached plans. Asphalt will be installed for the Jarrad Street carpark surface. The upgrade to these surfaces will reduce maintenance cost in the long term.
5. What is proposed for the playground upgrade?
A sports theme will form the principles of the playground upgrade, in accordance with the Public Open Space Strategy (2019). No design has been determined to date.
6. Are there any plans to upgrade the practice facilities for tennis, cricket and basketball?
There will be no plans to upgrade these facilities as part of this project and this can be done as part of any future works
7. What is the timing of the proposed improvements?
The improvements will occur over the next few years subject to available budget
8. Will there be a golf ball protection fence between Seaview golf course and Harvey Field?
Modifications to the golf course would be the preferred option with the fence being the last resort after all other engineering solutions have been exhausted. Surrounding residents will be consulted before this occurs.
