Frequently Asked Questions

How many workshops will be held?

The number of workshops to be held on the location of a skate facility in Cottesloe will be dependent on the level of community interest.

What are the locations being considered for the skate park?

Two potential locations are being considered - the Cottesloe foreshore and John Black Dune. The Cottesloe foreshore site incorporates the extension of the playground area northwards to accommodate for a skate park facility. John Black Dune falls within the carpark two development zone with sufficient unused area for a skate park facility to co-exist with the proposed development.

Will the workshops include discussions as to whether or not the skate park is going ahead?

The discussion will be centred on which of the two shortlisted locations is preferred by the community. There will be no discussion around whether or not the skate park will go ahead.

Will the workshops include discussions around the design of the skate park?

There will be no discussion regarding the design of the park at this workshop. There will however be further opportunities for community consultation, in the near future, regarding the skate park design.
