Beach Access Paths (BAPs) – Possible Closures and Upgrades 2021

1.	Why is the Town looking at changing the current foreshore paths layout?	The current layout has paths very closely spaced. The closure of selected paths to reasonably increase separation will provide cost saving opportunities through reduction in maintenance and replacement expenditure.
2.	Does having direct access to a BAP provide me with a greater say about what is to occur?	All feedback will be considered equally by Elected Members.
3.	How much impact will the changes have on the beach environment?	Paths that have been approved to be closed will be replaced with appropriate dune planting, improving the stability of the beach environment.
4.	Will parking issues be created with increased demand (due to less BAPs)?	No. Paths that have been closed are within reasonable walking distance to adjacent access points that remain open.
5.	What is meant by Universal Access?	In this instance universal access refers to a path that is designed to provide access for all, particularly those people with a disability or activity limitations.
