The 2015 initiative of ProCott was the initiation of Christmas decorations installations to Cottesloe Village to create a unique, welcoming and festive environment for our visitors. After the success and positive feedback from the initial phase in 2015, the board has decided to continue to increase the decorations as part of the initial 5 year proposal. The strategy is to increase the Christmas installations to include the entire Cottesloe Village and to provide an environment for our visitors to look forward to our each year.

We believe this decoration initiative is a key step in maximizing and capitalizing on the high level of goodwill and public awareness of Cottesloe Village, which sees visitors from across the suburbs of Perth. As a part of this initiative ProCott foresees the establishment of a community event incorporating the "Turning on The Village Christmas lights" once the number of decorations reach an adequate level throughout the Village.

Commencement has begun on our second year decoration purchases. With the generous assistance form the Town of Cottesloe in 2015 Procott was able to invest in 4 large free standing illuminated lights that took pride of place in Napoleon Street. This year we would like to replicate the order to extend the illuminated stars into Station and possibly Jarrad Street. This will assist in creating a unified, connected atmosphere throughout the area.

The cost of implementing these illuminated decorations is \$2855 per unit plus freight (ex east coast). The purchase of these items allows the reuse in the coming years. This is a substantial investment for Cottesloe Village, however we are confidant that they will continue to impress and provide a good return, and they could also be easily used in other locations around the Town of Cottesloe.

Procott will also incur the costs of more decorations for installation in the street trees plus the installation, removal and annual storage costs. We would greatly welcome the Council's assistance to acquire more stars, by provision of a grant. It is, we believe a purchase that adds great value to Cottesloe Village and to Cottesloe.

As our budget is limited we would like to be considered for and greatly appreciate any financial assistance available. I have attached relevant documents in support.
