

Yesterday I received an email from Garry Baverstock stating that he had not yet received full support to proceed with a planned eco-friendly development to be called 'Swanbourne Village' and which is to be discussed at tomorrow's council meeting ((Tuesday night 24 August 2016) for further discussion. Garry has requested that people contact City of Cottesloe mayor and councillors to ask why you are not supportive of climate sensible residential eco developments that will benefit society.

In fact, when I initially read Garry's email I did a double take because I couldn't believe that he and Josh Byrne were not receiving support of their pro-environmental residential development. if anyone knows how to design and build eco-friendly residential developments with climate sensible water and plant usage in Australia then it is Garry Baverstock and Josh Byrne. More details can be found on their website http://swanbournevillagetrust.com. I am also aware that Garry has received an Order of Australia for his groundworking work and significant contribution to sustainable architecture in Australia.

The reason I am writing to you is to find out if I am missing anything or is the City of Cottesloe simply not in support of environmentally-friendly residential developments? Surely the people of Cottesloe support this development. I can only conclude that we must all be missing something important.

I am keen to know why you are not in full support of this development, particularly when ratepayers from across metropolitan Perth have had to watch how many councils have permitted the design and construction of non eco-friendly developments. For example, as an owner of property in Perth city I wrote to the City of Perth in circa 2006 to ask them if they had a quota for the number of new apartment buildings they would permit to be constructed in the city; I also asked them about whether they were in support of green buildings. Their response was 'none' to the number of buildings stating that market forces would dictate the need for buildings and they would simply keep allowing any type of building to be constructed. The sad reality is the result we have today which is a very high number of rather empty apartment blocks in Perth and drastically falling rents (if they are even rented). I also live on a street in the City of Belmont and have sadly been witness to the ever-increasing number of lovely character homes on large blocks being demolished to be replaced with what my mother has described as 'congested dog box developments' that no-one wants to live in. I now live across the road from four dog box villas which have no gardens nor trees - all I see are four double garage doors and small entry doors (very ugly indeed). In fact, we now have many ugly new villas and apartments all over Perth and many people probably shed a tear (I do) at how unpleasant our suburbs have become so one cannot understand why a green sustainable residential development is without council support. With regard to my mother, she is nearing 80 and will need to downsize from her large property in Kalamunda but fears living in a poorly designed 'dog box' without ample natural light will not help her in her old age. There is sufficient evidence to suggest that people who live in eco homes are happier, healthier, and more satisfied with live and their contribution to the environment and economy. I'm sure Garry can provide you with the research.

I urge you to rethink your decision to potentially not support Garry Bavertsock and James Shaw of Ecotect Architects and Josh Byrne from Josh Byrne of Josh Byrne and Associates.





- I currently live at a couple of doors down from Congdon Street, but I used to own and live at Railway Street, 2 doors from the proposed. I actually sold that house at a loss in 2010 as I couldn't remain living there due to the fear I was in over the traffic and trying to get out of my driveway.
- 2. It was me who in 2009/10 lobbied the Council for the installation of the domed mirror opposite Railway Street, to assist me exiting my drive safely. I wrote to several councillors and made submissions and even the Post wrote an article about the issue with Railway Street and the blind corner at the intersection of Congdon Street. If the Council would go to the expense of putting the mirror in, it shows that Council acknowledged it is a dangerous stretch of road; and
- 3. In 2010 I reported an incident to the Cottesloe police relating to the traffic outside Railway Street. There is an automated gate into the property and one day when I was coming home, I was in Railway Street facing west waiting for the gate to open so I could turn in (I always stopped as far back from my house as possible so that the remote control would still work and so cars coming along Railway Street wouldn't come across me on the blind corner, but would see the back of my car earlier). Anyway on this day, a man came around the corner very fast and had to slam on his brakes and swerve so as not to hit me. He started gesticulating and swearing at me. As I was still waiting for the gate to open and couldn't move immediately, he then got out of his car came over to my driver's door and was trying to open it while still screaming abuse at me and this with my kids in the car (then aged 12, 9 and 6). They were terrified and I was so shaken up that I didn't (unfortunately) get his full licence plate and so the police said there was not much they could do, plus even if they did, it would be "my word against his".
- 4. The last straw was when our cat was run over and killed as I honestly felt that it would only be a matter of time until it was one of my children. Not long after this I put the house on the market and moved out in June 2010.
