Eric Street Shared Path Petition

Summary of reasons for request:

- 1) We were insufficiently notified of the extent and impact of The Path, and have not been provided with designs over the past year of its detailed development. It poses a material change to the nature of Eric Street.
- 2) We were unaware The Path was out to tender and slated to begin in a number of weeks (ie: September 2022 according to communications with tendering engineers).
- 3) We have not been invited to participate in the confidential ATWG meeting of May 12th 2022 where the in-progress plans for The Path were presented and refined.
- 4) As per Town of Cottesloe Community Engagement Policy 2019, and given The Path is at a minimum a “Site Specific Project” at Communications Matrix level 3 (“Survey” and unaddressed “Letter drop” to date) then we have been inadequately informed of The Path and should reasonably expect to be informed via “Ad in paper”, “Mayor’s newsletter”, “Letter” [directly addressed to residents], “Media release”, and an opportunity for a “Personal Briefing”.
- 5) We have not been adequately involved according to the Town of Cottesloe standard of IAP2 guidelines which council has committed to following. Reporting on the limited June 2021 online community survey on The Path, it was noted by the Cottesloe Corporate Services and Engagement Officer in their “Key Findings” for the survey that in reference to affected stakeholders:
 1. “it is clear that this group do not support the proposal”
 2. “The result would suggest that further consultation with the affected stakeholder group may be required to address their concerns.”
 3. “There is potential to explore solutions before finalising the Eric Street Cycle Path with the affected stakeholders (IAP2 Public Participation Level Involve).”Subsequent to the above there has been no further consultation with the involved stakeholders in The Path, and the only published meeting was planned and held under confidential circumstances and closed to the public.
- 6) Despite assurances from, and requests to, council employees, no road or bicycle safety audit for The Path has been produced to date. The Path appears to not meet a number of road and bicycle safety and design standards¹ and poses several concerns to the safety of the residents of Cottesloe.
- 7) There are potential liability implications for the Town of Cottesloe (and by virtue, its ratepayers) should a shared path for bicycles be installed on Eric Street. Western Australia has no speed limit for cyclists on shared paths, and there exist legal views which support the notion of a Local Government bearing liability for any injuries inflicted upon pedestrians by cyclists on shared paths on Crown Land.
