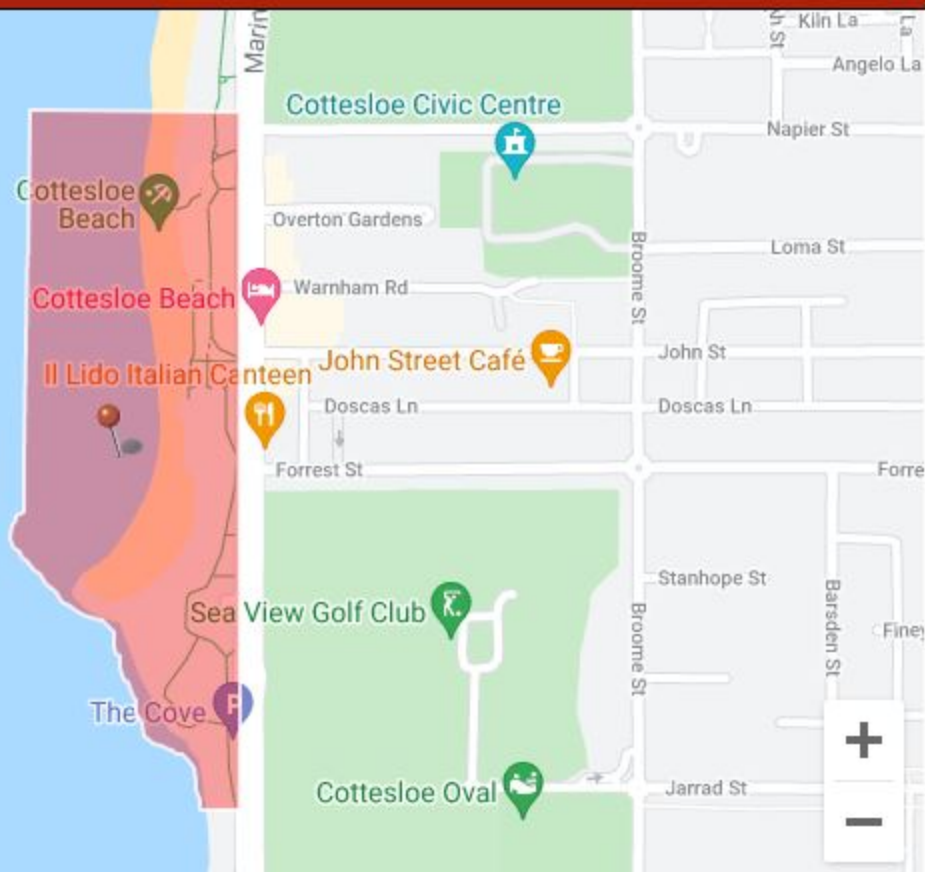

Hi Shane

At the moment the purpose of the appeal is very narrow – ‘to restore the bell component of the heritage listed Cottesloe Pylon’. The funds can only be used to restore the bell component. However, we could probably stretch that to include the structural studies you mention.

I would recommend however that the appeal be reviewed and the scope broadened – ‘to conserve, restore and interpret the Cottesloe Pylon’ for example. Then works that contributed to its conservation and restoration, which would include investigative works, conservation/restoration works and interpretation (which could include events but they would have to be consistent with the appeal purpose and the objects of the National Trust) could be supported.

The National Trust can also host an online donation page for the appeal which is doing well at attracting donations for other appeals because they can be made online. This also means that the Town of Cottesloe doesn’t need to write NTWA receipts for those donations as receipts are automatically generated. 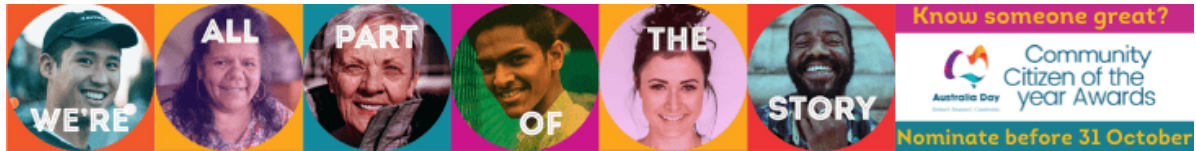

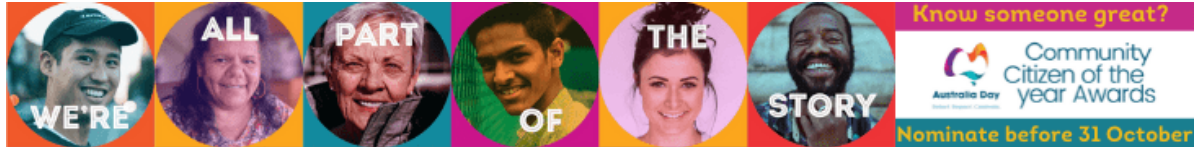
