

## TOWN OF COTTESLOE 2 6 APR 2016

RECEIVED

As the undersigned residents of Princes Street, other nearby streets, and other concerned Cottesloe residents who frequent Princes Street, we would like to request a tree planting program, preferably including at least some Norfolk Pine trees for Princes Street.

This would be in keeping with the surrounding area. The following matters are relevant:

- 1. Streets on either side of Princes Street, namely Beach Street and Salvado Street, have established street trees. Princes Street, particularly between Avonmore Tce and Marine Parade is barren. There is no shade at all between Avonmore Tce and Marine Pde.
- 2. All the streets running parallel to Princes Street in this area, namely Pearse, Deane, Rosendo, Salvado and Beach streets, all have lovely street trees (Norfolk Pines). As you turn into these streets from Marine Parade, you are welcomed by the beginning of an avenue of green. These trees create shade and ambience for residents and still allow views of the ocean. The uniformity and general style of the area should be the determining factor in deciding what would suit this street.
- 3. Originally there were some Norfolk Pines in this street. Over time they have disappeared: they have been removed either for new crossovers or because they were inside a property. Other trees have been removed or destroyed intentionally.
- 4. Recently Princes Street residents were contacted by the Council and given an "option" to have a street tree. With respect, this should not be an option. The Council has an obligation to manage the suburb. This includes the verges: for the benefit of all, not just those concerned that a tree may interrupt their view. One of the native shrubs planted has already been intentionally damaged. Three appear to have been poisoned.
- 5. When contacted in 2015 with the option of having a street tree, those who nominated Norfolk Pines were told they could not have them because they were not appropriate for the street. This follows intensive complaints to Mr Doug Elkins from a few residents in Princes Street who do not want ANY trees.
- 6. Earlier this year the Council planted two mature Norfolk Pines on the verge on the corner of Avonmore Terrace and 9 Princes Street following a major renovation of that property. Neighbours pressured the owner of that property to make a request to Council to have the trees removed. The Council removed the trees, much to the disappointment of many local residents.
- 7. The majority of people in Princes Street, and in Cottesloe appreciate shade, particularly in summer as our summers get longer and hotter. A few anti-tree residents should not have the power to have perfectly healthy trees removed. We believe there must be a firm Council policy that is not overridden by a minority.
- 8. There are now several large residences in the vicinity of the intersection of Avonmore Tce and Beach St and not one has a verge tree. The homes are substantial and verge trees in proportion to the size and height of the homes would be appropriate. The entire street looks barren and totally out of keeping with the surrounding area. It is not a pleasant street to walk. The street has become a mass of bricks and mortar and dry verges, lacking the benefits of a tree-lined street for shade and ambience.

We would like to ask the Council to review this whole area and prepare a proper verge planting plan for Princes Street in keeping with the South Cottesloe area and the general feel of Cottesloe.

Part of the reason we choose to live in this suburb is because of its shady tree-lined streets. We feel the local residents are entitled to benefit from the same care Council gives to other streets and enjoy a beautiful green street.
