To Cottesloe Council:

I am writing further to correspondence with Sherilee Macready and Garry Bird in order to request a donation from the Town of Cottesloe for the ICEA Classic, coming up on the 11th of September. As long term community partners of the event, I am sure the Council knows that the ICEA Classic is an event that celebrates rich Indigenous cultures and young surfing talent, and brings people together in the spirit of reconciliation. Now in its seventh year, the Classic is attracting around 7000 people with plans for it to continue growing. We are particularly focused on expanding the cultural aspect of the event, with a record number of cultural facilitators joining us on the 11th, meaning we are more in need of the support of our partners and sponsors than ever to ensure we continue to provide an efficient, safe, fun and impressive community event to our patrons. We hope that you will be able to work with us in this endeavor.

ICEA is requesting a \$5000 donation from the Town of Cottesloe, consistent with what they have contributed to the event in the past. This amount will directly cover the cost of the Welcome to Country ceremony conducted by Professor Len Collard as well as his facilitation of Cultural Tours at the Cove and surrounding landmarks on the day. Further, this amount will cover the cost of two young Indigenous dance groups – the Wesley Moorditj Mob and the PLC Goorna Liyarn Dancers – to perform on the day.

The total project budget is \$54 036. This budget includes infrastructure for the event (marquees, staging, safety barriers, sound equipment, lighting), security, entertainment and performances, cultural facilitators and activities, marketing and promotion, volunteer/personnel costs as well as food, merchandise and other necessary materials. We have plans in place for this year's event to be a more refined version of what the Classic has been in the past, and the budget has grown slightly because of that. We are extremely lucky and fortunate to receive the community support that we do, including some in-kind sponsorship deals, but we are still seeking further support.
