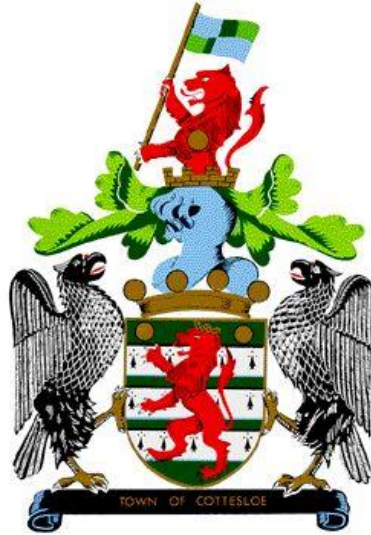

4. DISCUSSION**4.1 Development of Public Art Strategy**

Discussion of the draft strategy as circulated. The committee raised the following as key points of interest:

- Providing appropriate marketing promotion materials
- Using art for way finding – location identification
- Icarus placement issues should be considered in the strategy
- Strategy should consider issues such as scale for each location, etc.
- Horizon (adjacent OBH) still incredibly popular and is a great demonstrator of the objectives of public art
- Eric Street shopping centre (donated piece) good example of an appropriate piece
- Daisies was listed as a place that could benefit
- Needs to be a location identification to work out what the criteria are for each location
- Broome Street (Cottesloe Natural Garden) potential site
- Some further consideration given to iconic spots rather than just what sites are available
- Trailguide (Northcliffe) 'Under Story' put forward as an example of the discipline required to ensure we remain 'site specific'

- Mindful of CoastCare and environmental considerations, potential input into sites
- Ron Gombok (Grant Marine Park) another positive example
- Pylon – impact and return is very high
- East – west sculpture boulevards / adopt a sculpture (community identifies and owns the sculpture) – street to select and be involved...
- Mural's to be considered in the mix (Laundromat wall / mural of a map), not just sculptures on existing infrastructure...(Banners in the terrace – annual opportunity)
- Claremont – use of art in the commercial space (in partnership with Form)
- Looking for initiatives and projects to consider beyond involvement with Sculpture by the Sea
- Lighting, lit artwork can improve public safety
- Kinetic sculpture (Golden section) – potential additions/partnering that sculpture
- Entry statements for the Town - including Cottesloe Village

Action: Committee members to provide thoughts on strategy and current collection for consideration.
