COTTESLOE JETTY HISTORY INSTALLED AT NATURE SPACE

The Cottesloe Nature Discovery Space has a brand new entrance - and it's steeped in history! It's made out of wood that formed part of the old Cottesloe Jetty.

When the Town commenced work to build new access stairs at Cottesloe Main Beach in August 2020, an excavator uncovered burnt out timber and long pieces of intact timber under the concrete and sand. They were from an old timber groyne that formed a retaining wall at the base of the jetty. The Town salvaged the wood and stored it away safely to use for something special... a grand new entrance with an amazing story.
