SOUTH WARD EXTRAORDINARY ELECTION 2023

An extraordinary election will be held on Saturday, 25 February 2023 to fill a Councillor vacancy in the South Ward until the local government election in October next year. The vacancy was created when Councillor Caroline Harben resigned in October. Electors in South Ward are eligible to vote for the new Councillor.

Dates to note: **Electoral roll closes at 5pm on Friday, 6 January, nominations for candidates open on 12 January and close at 4pm on 19 January, election packages (i.e voting forms) will be sent by mail from approximately 27 January.**

Information about the upcoming election will be published by the Western Australian Electoral Commission and the Town will keep our community informed as this information becomes available.

PARKING AND PARKING FACILITIES LOCAL LAW 2023

In accordance with section 3.12(3)(a) of the Local Government Act 1995, Local Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Cottesloe proposes to make a Parking and Parking Facilities Local Law 2023.

The purpose of the Local Law is to provide for the orderly control and regulation of Parking Facilities within the Town of Cottesloe. The effect of the Local Law is to ensure that all matters associated with parking within the district are governed by this Local Law unless otherwise provided in the Act, regulations or other written law.
