**4. WALGA ROAD SAFETY UPDATE**

Ms Celenza advised the Committee of the following:

- Current road fatality statistics – 30 deaths, eight more than the same time last year.
- National Road Safety week to be held from 6 May 2019 to 12 May 2019 to coincide with UN Global Road Safety week. Kit on initiatives available including Friday 10 May 2019, Shine a Light on Road Safety.
- Road Safety Commission, Road Safety Strategy consultation to be undertaken. Registration of interest available.
- Ride to School Day to be held 22 March 2018 and Walk Safely to School Day to be held 17 May 2019.

- Nomination forms available for the RoadWise Human Spirit award.

## 6. CRIME UPDATE

### 6.1 Police Update

Sgt Gazzone advised the Committee of the following:

- Stealing offences are the lowest in the last four years.
- Main offence is theft from cars.
- There is an increase in crime in January, February and March each year.
- An operation took place on the trains involving Police and Transit Officers.
- An operation took place involving Regional Operations Group and Traffic Enforcement Group targeting anti social behaviour in the area.
- The Town of Mosman Park received a grant for CCTV.
- Snr Sgt Warburton wants to arrange a Local Government 'summit' to discuss safety issues.

## 7. SENIOR RANGER REPORT

Ms Squiers advised the Committee of the following:

- The Rottneest Channel Swim went well.
- Sculpture by the Sea exhibition starts next week.
- Second full time Ranger has started, with Rangers roster being 6.00am until 7.30pm.
- Rangers are trialling body cams.
- A few homeless people are around the area. They have been provided 'care packs' providing information on places to go.
- CCTV in Station Street has been updated.
- School education program to be started.

- Approximate cost for Station Street, Napoleon Street and Jarrad Street CCTV to be installed is \$170,000.

Sgt Gazzone queried the use of artificial intelligence technology in association with CCTV. The Committee discussed future possibilities.

**9.2 Foreshore Works Update (discussed after item 3)**

Mr Kan advised the Committee of the following:

- Shady seating works adjacent to the Cottesloe Surf Life Saving Club stairs will resume in April 2019.
- Foreshore Masterplan will be advertised for public consultation (including stakeholders).
- Beach Access Paths S10, S12 and N6 have been completed. N7 is currently being constructed to be completed mid March 2019.

**9.3 Barchetta and North Cottesloe Surf Life Saving Club Floodlights**

Cr Thomas advised the Committee that Cr Young had raised concerns that the floodlights near Barchetta and North Cottesloe Surf Life Saving Club are not working. Mr Bird advised the Committee that there is an item to be considered by Council at the Ordinary Council Meeting, 26 February 2019 and that there will need to be clarification of the lease to determine who is responsible for the maintenance of the lights.
