Work has commenced on a new playground on the foreshore at Dutch Inn. An upgrade for this playground was deemed as high priority through the Town's Public Open Space and Playground Strategy, adopted by Council in November 2019.

The new playground will feature a shipwreck frame with climbing ropes and slides, monkey bars, a carousel, all abilities swing, wobble boards, log steppers and rock climbers. Following installation of the playground the area will be landscaped and planted with local native species.

The Town has been successful in a grant application through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program and will receive a \$218,000 contribution from the Federal Government for this upgrade.

Weather permitting, construction of the new Dutch Inn playground will be completed and open for use in early September.

GRANT FUNDING FOR BEN SIGNS

The Town of Cottesloe has been successful in securing grant funding to install Beach Emergency Numbers (BEN) signs at our beach paths.

The BEN sign system includes a unique code on each sign to improve emergency response times, providing specific location information in the event of a beach emergency.

A BEN sign will be installed at the top of each beach path in Cottesloe and, where it is not visible from beach level, at the bottom of some beach paths. The signs will be installed in time for the busy summer season on the beach.

DOG EXERCISE AREAS - REMINDER

Please remember that there are many off-lead dog exercise areas in the Town of Cottesloe and as per the Dog Act 1976, dogs must be on their lead and under effective control at all other times in public open spaces.

Dogs can be off-lead at two locations on Cottesloe Beach; the southern dog beach (south of Dutch Inn Groyne to Cottesloe LGA southern boundary) and the northern dog beach (fro Lot 67 Marine Parade to Cottesloe LGA northern boundary). Dogs can also be off-lead at Cottesloe Oval and Harvey Field, John Black Dune Reserve, Grant Marine Park, Andrews Place, Jasper Green Reserve and at Sea View golf course between 6pm and 6am only.

Locations near the train line include open space along Curtin Avenue and Railway Street to the Public Transport Authority boundary fence.
