FORESHORE REPAIR WORKS

In the winter of 2020, the Rotunda and surrounding area on the foreshore were badly damaged by a storm of unusual intensity. Since the damage occurred the Town has been managing an insurance claim and working on a design solution to repair the damage and stabilise the surrounding dunes.

An engineered concept design was approved by Council in May this year, and at the September 2021 Ordinary Council Meeting, Council awarded the tender for the works to landscape construction firm Environmental Industries.

The works include a drainage system designed for large storm events. In times of very heavy rainfall, when local drainage networks are unable to cope with excess stormwater, the overflow will be directed across the footpath and on to a vegetated area at the bottom of the dunes. This will filter pollutants from the water before it reaches the ocean. Litter trapped in the vegetation will be picked up and disposed of as part of the Town's regular beach clean up program. An ocean pipe outfall is not part of the design and polluted water will not be directed into the ocean.

Reconstruction work will commence shortly, to enable the area to be open for beach users as soon as possible.



E-BIKES IN COTT

The Town of Cottesloe has joined forces with e-bike specialists BYKKO to trial an e-bike rental scheme in the Town. Local operator Ozie Bike is running the program of 12 e-bikes located in three integrated bike docking systems (four bikes in each) which have a mobile device check out allowing you to rent an e-bike whenever you like. SUMMER SWIMMING

Cottesloe's protected swimming enclosure was reinstalled this week for another summer of relaxed beach swimming. This is the third season the shark barrier has been installed at Cottesloe Main Beach for the summer season, providing a comfortable swimming space for everyone to enjoy. The barrier will be available to swim in all summer and will be removed at the end of March next year to be stored for winter.
