TIME TO RENEW YOUR PET REGISTRATION

Dog and cat registrations expire on 31 October. If your pet was last registered for one year or is coming to the end of a three year registration, it's time for it to be renewed.

Under the West Australian Dog Act 1976 all dogs must be registered with your local Council. Under the Western Australian Cat Act 2011, cats aged six months and over must be registered. It is an offence not to register your pet.
