7.1 Eric Street Cycle Path Concept Design

Item by Director Engineering Services - Mr Shaun Kan

SUMMARY

Administration have further progressed the initial concept design to a stage ready for detailed design to commence. The proposed route has a few minor modifications to allow better connectivity to the existing Perth to Fremantle - Principal Shared Path and North Cottesloe Primary School.

\$70,000 in grant funding is available in the 2021/2022 Financial Year to commence the detailed design.

BACKGROUND

In 2018, a community consultation survey was completed during the development of the Towns Long Term Cycle Network. Eric Street was determined as a route to be considered for the Long Term Bike Cycle Network.

In April 2020, the Cottesloe Council unanimously supported the LTCN plan for the Town. The active transport working group provided administration a concept design for the Eric Street shared path.

Since this time the administration have submitted to Department of transport a WA bicycle Network Grant application which has since successful with funding to commence detailed design works.

PROPOSED APPROACH

It is intended that:

- Working group provides feedback on the preferred layout
- Information will be considered by the Administration to finalise the RFQ documentation to commence detailed design works.

INTENDED OUTCOME FROM MEETING

- (1) Provide Feedback on the attached Concept Design
- (2) Notes that the attached plan will be provided to Council for acceptance for the purpose of public consultation
- (3) Notes that stakeholders consulted will predominantly be businesses and residents along Eric Street between Marine Parade and Curtin Avenue
