



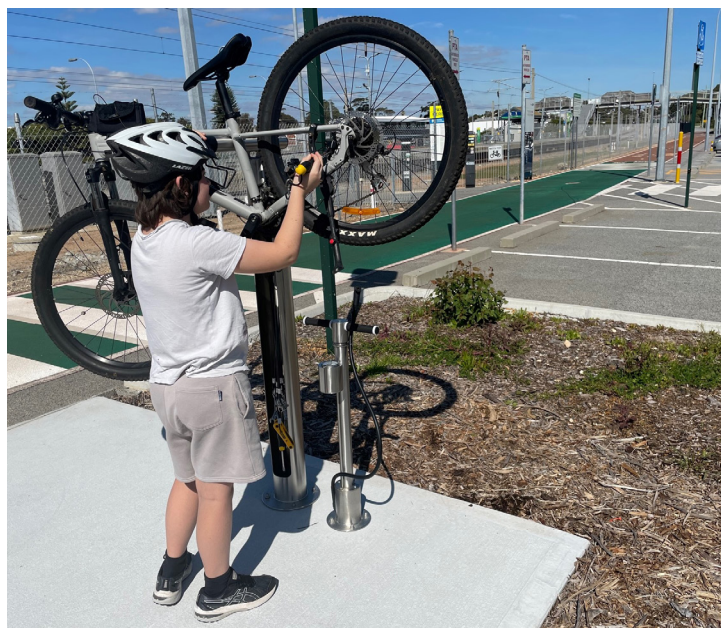
## NOMINATE SOMEONE GREAT!
