

**REQUEST FOR BUDGET COSTING OF RE-GROUTING STONEMWORK AT
THE MAIN COTTESLOE BEACH.**

Dear Sir,

At the 24th Feb Council Meeting I made a presentation to Council on various issues (copy enclosed).to which Mr Goeff Trigg replied by letter ref: SUB/1529.

The most urgent of these issues is **THE NEED TO RE-GROUT THE RETAINING WALLS AND STAIRCASES BETWEEN THE PLAYGROUND OPPOSITE OVERTON GARDENS AND THE MAIN BEACH STAIRCASE OPPOSITE JOHN ST WHICH ARE IN URGENT NEED OF PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE** and if not repaired will lead to very extensive repairs and re-building.

I am told that there are major changes under consideration for the front car park but even if the top wall is to be lowered in height in the future all of the other levels are still in urgent need of preventative maintenance so the money would be well spent.

The purpose of this letter is to request that a costing be done on the necessary re-grouting in time to be submitted to Council FOR THE COMING BUDGET ALLOCATION for next financial year.

I am told by Mr Trigg, who advised me to write to you that there has been no costing done on this to date so I am anxious to have a costing done in time for Budget submissions.
